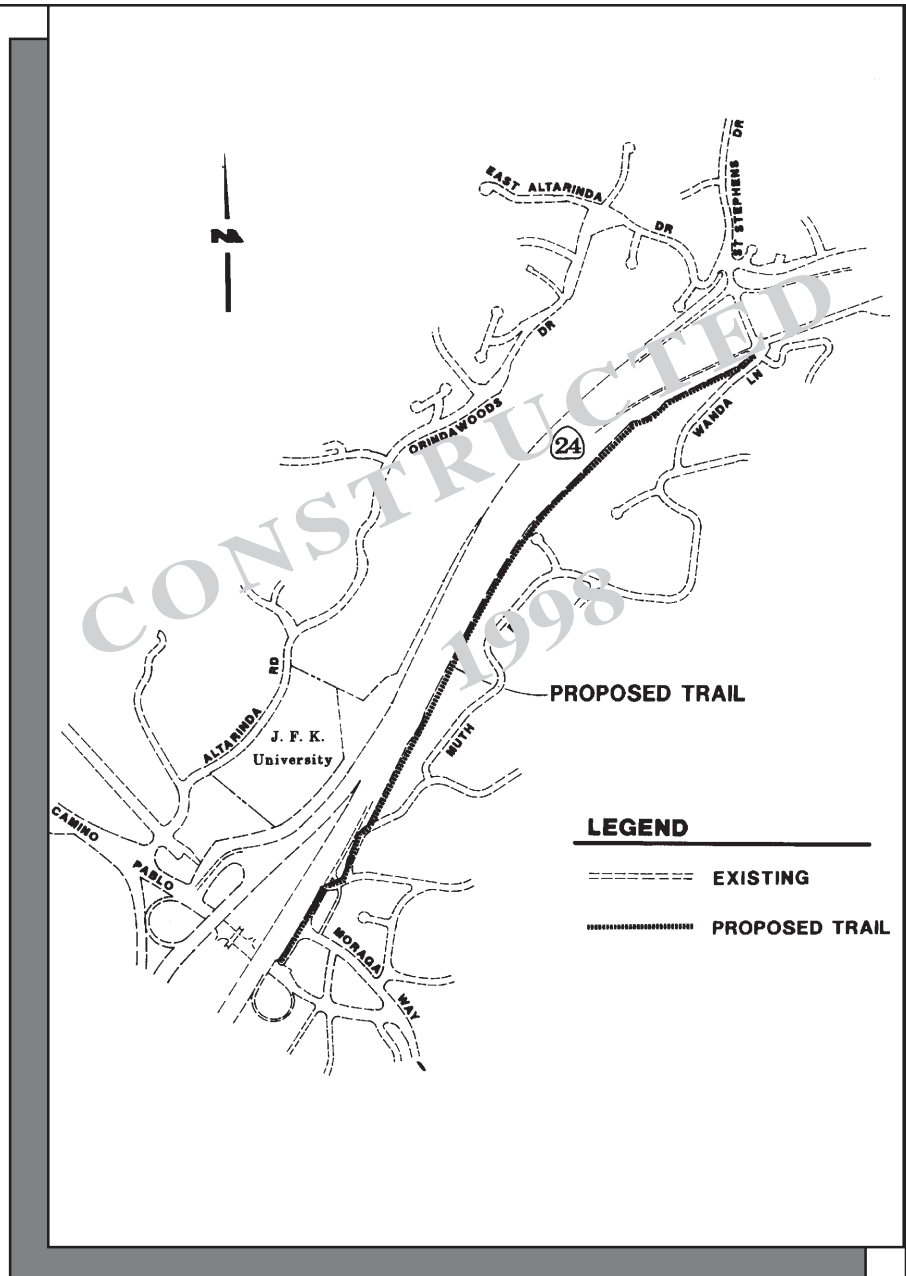

DESCRIPTION:

This project created a bicycle path and pedestrian trail southeast of State Route 24 along the freeway right-of-way and the Contra Costa County Sanitation District fee strip. It connects existing paths on Camino Pablo Road and St. Stephens Drive. Existing topography and trees were preserved as much as possible. Trees that had to be removed were either be relocated or mitigated within the right-of-way.

STATUS:

Construction completed in 1998 with the exception of the guardrail, landscaping and water meter, which were completed in Spring 2002.
