

**I-680 AUXILIARY LANES (SEGMENTS 1 & 3) --- LANDSCAPING
CCO's GREATER THAN \$25,000**

Proj. CCO No. Description of Change Order

1106 8 Iron Horse Trail Lighting at I-680 & Laurel Drive.

This CCO was issued to compensate the contractor to install soffit lighting on the I-680 Bridge over the Iron Horse Trail adjacent to Laurel Drive in Danville. The widening of the bridge for the freeway auxiliary lanes and the construction of seismic infill walls between the bridge support columns significantly reduced the ambient lighting along the Iron Horse Trail as it traverses underneath the I-680 Bridge. Authority staff discussed the situation with the design consultant, the Town of Danville, Caltrans, and the East Bay Regional Parks District (owner and operator of the trail). Approval was obtained from Caltrans, the Park District, and the Town of Danville to install a lighting system for the trail area underneath the freeway bridge. However, it was too late to include this CCO work with the freeway widening and bridge construction contract. Therefore, this CCO work is being included with the current Landscaping contract which is currently being administered by the Authority. After installation is complete, the East Bay Regional Parks District will be the owner and operator of the trail lighting system.

This CCO amount is \$30,001.20 and is funded from the project's Contingency funds.
