

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Town of Moraga – Moraga Traffic Study (Project 1620): Resolution #05-13-P (rev. 1)</b>
<b>Summary of Issues</b>	The Town of Moraga is requesting an amendment to Resolution #05-13-P. The resolution was approved with an appropriation of \$211,000 to conduct the Moraga Traffic Study (Project 1620). The study has been completed, with approximately \$73,000 remaining in the resolution. Consistent with the study recommendation, the Town is conducting a Specific Plan and an Environmental Impact Report for the Moraga center area. The Town is requesting a resolution amendment to amend the scope of work to cover the traffic analysis part of the Specific Plan.
<b>Recommendations</b>	Staff recommends approval of Resolution amendment #05-13-P rev1.
<b>Financial Implications</b>	No change in the amount appropriated or programmed for this project in the <i>2005 Strategic Plan</i> .
<b>Options</b>	The Authority could choose to reject or alter this request.

**Background**

In September 2005, the Town of Moraga obtained a Measure C appropriation of \$211,000 to conduct the Moraga Traffic Study (Project 1620). The final study identified opportunities to reduce traffic density between Moraga and Highway 24 through various land use alternatives.

In order to further the work of the Study, the Town of Moraga is developing a Specific Plan for the Moraga Center Area. This area has been identified as a potential Priority Development Area through the FOCUS program. In order to complete the planning for this area, the Town is preparing an Environmental Impact Report for the proposed higher density residential and local-serving commercial development. The Town is requesting that the Authority revise the resolution approving the use of Measure C funds for the Moraga Traffic Study such that the remaining funds could be directed toward the traffic analysis portion of the Specific Plan.
