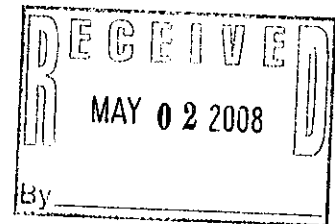

Dear Chair Hudson:

At its meeting on April 10, 2008, TRANSPAC took the following actions that may be of interest to the Transportation Authority.

1. Approved the TAC's recommendation that the net new peak hour vehicle trip threshold should be 500 for evaluation. The project notification threshold remains at 100 net new peak hour vehicle trips. Reviewed and discussed changes to the Regional Transportation Mitigation Program (RTMP) and trip thresholds. Requested that the TAC continue to work on refining the language.
2. Discussed the issues concerning development of the MTSOs in the Action Plan. The TAC was asked to a) review the analysis of the TSOs in the previous Action Plan when available; b) review WCCTAC's TSOs for I-80; c) continue discussing development of objectives, and report to TRANSPAC in May or June.
3. Approved the Regional Measure 2 I-680 HOV Gap Closure Study budgets for FY 2008-09.
