At its meeting on May 10, 2007, TRANSPAC took the following actions that may be of interest to the Transportation Authority.

1. Reappointed John Hall, City of Walnut Creek, Richard Pearson, City of Martinez and Eric Hu, City of Pleasant Hill as TRANSPAC's TCC representatives for the April 2007 to March 2009 term.
2. Approved the City of Martinez's request to seek an Advance of Measure J funds for the Martinez Intermodal Project.
3. Approved the submission of a 2008 STIP application for a \$1.2 million restriping project on I-680 sponsored by CCTA or other appropriate agency.
4. Received an update on the Pacheco Transit Hub Project by Cindy Dahlgren, Director of Administration, Central Contra Costa Transit Authority.
5. Approved the TAC's recommended revisions to Measure J Additional Policies to be sent under separate cover.
6. Approved the Updated Measure J Strategic Plan Programming for TRANSPAC projects to be submitted to the Authority under separate cover.
7. Approved the proposed Measure C reprogramming request for Contra Costa Boulevard Signal retiming project.
