



PACHECO BOULEVARD WIDENING

**PROPONENT:

DESCRIPTION:

This project consists of widening Pacheco Boulevard between Blum Road and Arthur Road in the Martinez area. The road serves as a local road and a parallel route to Interstate 680. The closure of Solano Way has left Pacheco Boulevard as the main north/south connector in the area other than Interstate 680.

STATUS:

The project consists of several phases and is in the planning stage. The project development and the environmental documents for relocating the overcrossing and realigning the road near the railroad have been completed. The County is planning to coordinate the railroad work with the Interstate 680/ State Route 4 Interchange reconstruction project.

Project phases will be completed as funding becomes available.

The first two phases will widen Pacheco Boulevard between Blum Road and south Martinez City limit to two lanes per direction and a center two way left turn lane (Phase 1); and between south Martinez City limit and north Martinez City limit to two lanes in each direction (Phase 2).
