



BANCROFT ROAD/ HOOKSTON ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

DESCRIPTION:

The intersection improvements consisted of installing a traffic signal, constructing curb, gutter, sidewalk, and drainage improvements, and reconstructing a portion of the existing pavement. In addition, Iron Horse Trail (class I trail) was extended between Mayhew Way and Hookston Road. This project was jointly sponsored by the cities of Concord and Pleasant Hill, East Bay Regional Park District and the County, with Concord being the lead agency. Measure C dollars funded design and a portion of construction.

STATUS:

Improvements to the intersection and the trail between Mayhew Way and Hookston Road, including realignment of the trail at the northern part of the Bancroft/Hookston intersection, were completed in November 2004.
