



**SR 4 (E) WIDENING:
SOMERSVILLE ROAD TO
SR-160**

DESCRIPTION:

This project will widen SR 4 from two to four lanes in each direction, from just west of Somersville Road to Hillcrest Avenue and then from two to three lanes in each direction to the interchange with SR 160 and the new SR 4 Bypass. This project will also provide a wide median for future transit. The total project length is approximately 5.3 miles. The widening project includes the reconstruction of the Somersville Road, Contra Loma/L Street, Lone Tree Way/A Street, and Hillcrest Avenue interchanges and the G Street Overcrossing and Cavallo Road undercrossing.

STATUS:

Construction will be completed in four segments starting from west to east. Construction on first segment began in April 2010.
