

WIDEN EASTBOUND HIGHWAY 24 OFF-RAMP AT BROOKWOOD ROAD

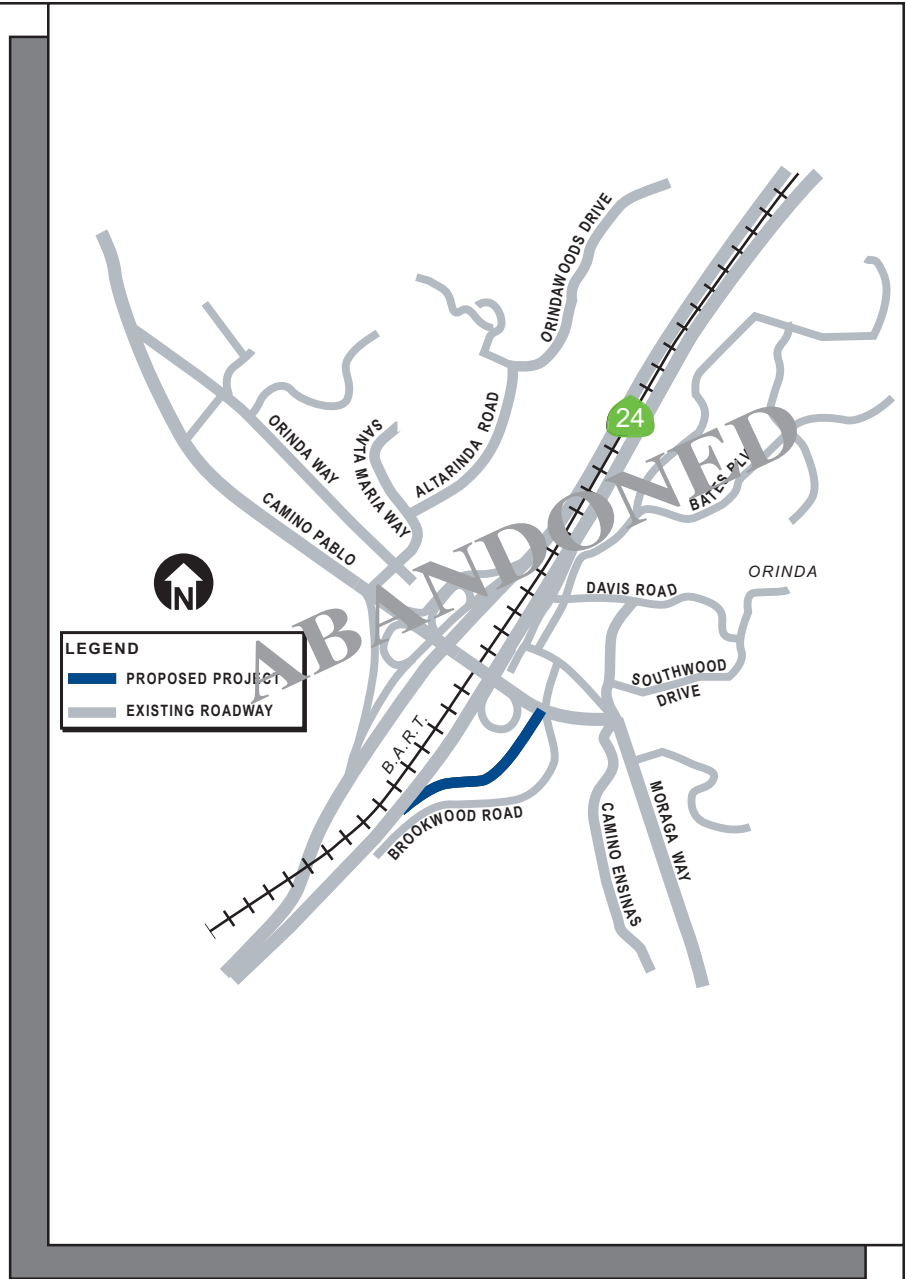
DESCRIPTION:

This project will widen the east-bound State Route 24 off-ramp at Brookwood Road and upgrade the signals. The signal upgrade work is completed (Phase I). The project will add a second lane to the off-ramp to provide storage for the commute traffic that currently backs up on to State Route 24 during the evening commute. The signals and the additional turn lane will provide better traffic flow at the intersection of Camino Pablo and Brookwood Road. The project also proposes to construct noise barriers south of the off-ramp.

This project is the second phase in a sequence of inter-related projects to improve operations at the Brookwood off-ramp.

STATUS:

A Caltrans supplemental project study report (PSR) on the project was completed in Fall 2001. Caltrans indicated that they will pursue State Highway Operations and Protection Program (SHOPP) funding for the project. No additional Measure C funds have been programmed for this project. The City of Orinda is not in support of the project.
