



**SYCAMORE VALLEY RD IMPROVEMENTS**

**DESCRIPTION:**  
The project will restripe Sycamore Valley Road between Camino Ramon Road and Brookside Road to provide additional westbound travel lane and a 5 foot bike lane. The additional lane will provide increased storage space for traffic making a right turn at the I-680 northbound on-ramp. Currently, queues on westbound Sycamore Valley Rd extend beyond Camino Ramon impeding westbound through traffic.

The final construction of westbound approach of Sycamore Valley Rd will be three 12-foot lanes, one 5-foot bike lane, and a meandering sidewalk. The sidewalk within the Iron Horse Trail and right of way will be relocated away from the intersection of Sycamore Valley Rd/Camino Ramon Rd/Park & Ride entrance on the north eastern corner.
