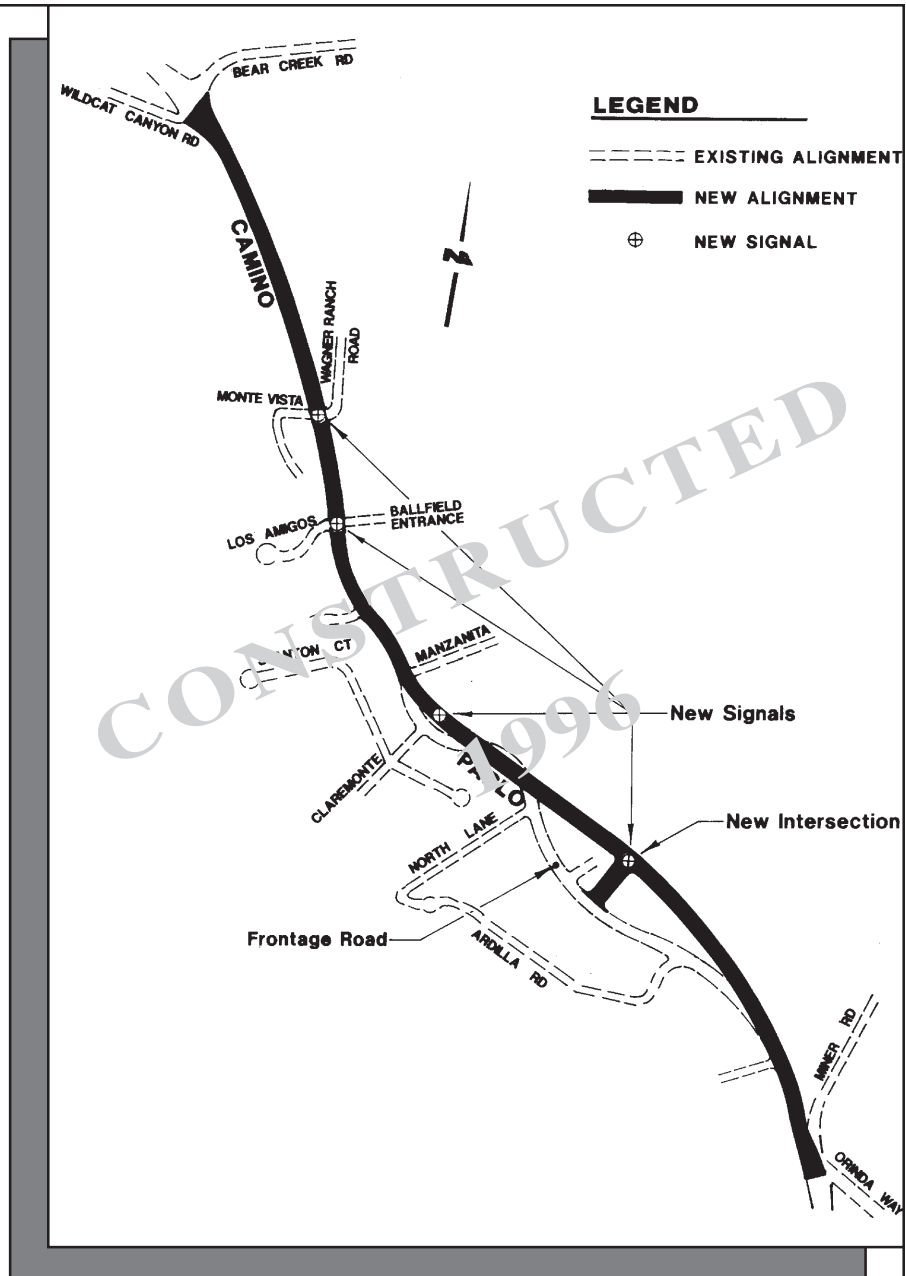
DESCRIPTION:

Camino Pablo is the southeast portion of the San Pablo Dam Corridor, and is used as a link between the Richmond area and central Contra Costa County. It is often used to bypass traffic congestion on the I-80 corridor and has high peak-hour volumes creating local congestion in the City of Orinda.

The Camino Pablo project improved and realigned Camino Pablo in Orinda as a two-lane roadway and provided left turn lanes and separated pedestrian and bicycle paths.

Construction completed in 1996.
