



MARTINEZ BAY TRAIL

DESCRIPTION:

The San Francisco Bay Trail, Phase II, will complete a 2,600 foot portion of the trail through the City of Martinez. This phase of the trail will begin at the existing Nejedly Staging Area on Carquinez Scenic Drive (within the East Bay Regional Park District Carquinez Regional Shoreline) and follow an easement along the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way to the existing public grade crossings at Berrellesa Street. At this point, the trail will head north on the east side of Berrellesa Street and provide a connection into the Martinez Regional Shoreline, which in turn provides connection to downtown Martinez and the existing Bay Trail on Marina Vista to the east.

STATUS:

City has completed the portion of the trail from Nejedly staging area to the Union Pacific Railroad and from Berrellesa Street to Ferry Street. The remaining portion along the railroad will be completed by the East Bay Regional Park District once R/W issues are resolved issuing non-Measure C funds.
