DESCRIPTION:

The Richmond Transit Village BART Parking Structure will expand parking supply at the BART station by approximately 150 spaces to 785 spaces. The project will construct a 635-space, five-level parking structure that will replace surface parking at the BART station, free up land for Richmond Transit Village residential units on the east side of the station (99 units), and add approximately 150 additional parking spaces.

The parking structure will be built to BART standards by the Richmond Redevelopment Agency on BART property, and will be owned and maintained by BART. The project is environmentally cleared and no right-of-way is required.
