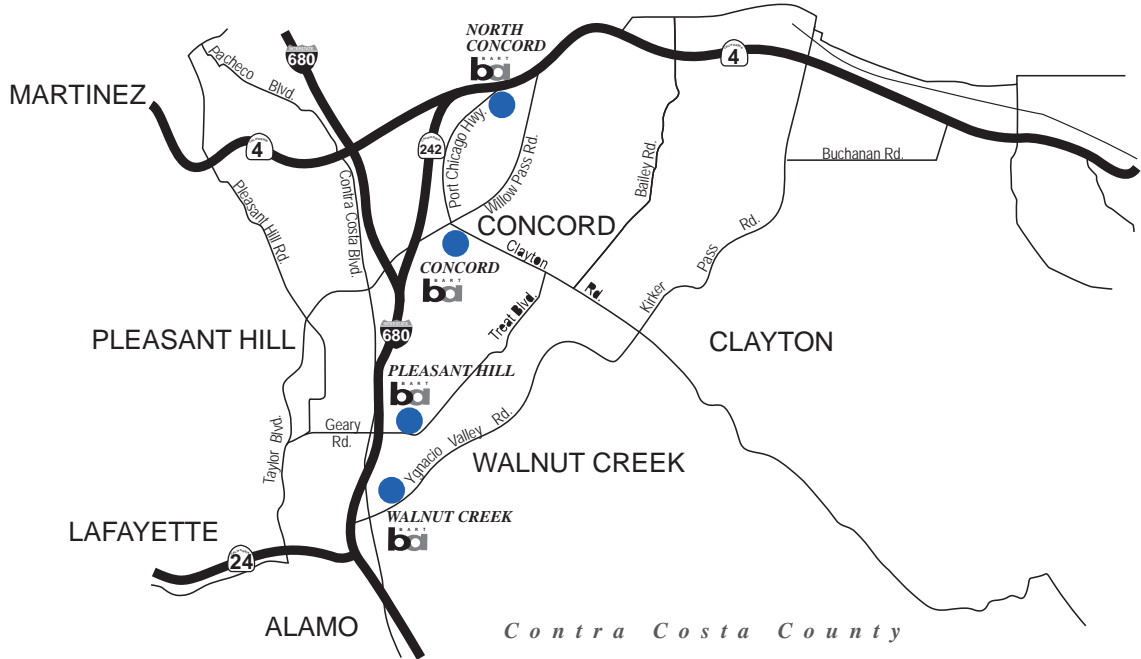

Project Scope

Install access improvements including pedestrian amenities, station capacity improvements, sidewalks, lighting/restroom renovations, bicycle storage, expanded automatic fare collection equipment, and others at the four Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BART) stations in Central County.

Access improvements at Central County BART Stations (cont.)

Need/Purpose

BART has prepared comprehensive station plans for three of the four central county stations. They provide prioritized lists of improvements that will enhance station access.

These funds would be used to improve pedestrian, bicycle, transit and car-sharing opportunities at the Central County BART stations. In addition, these funds may be used for station capacity and safety improvements.

Possible Segmentation

Improvements can be phased by station.

Issues

Two of the Central County BART stations have active transit village development. These funds are not intended to replace other public or private funds that are earmarked or intended to improve access to these stations.

Current Status

BART is awaiting funding to implement station access plans, phased as budget allows.
