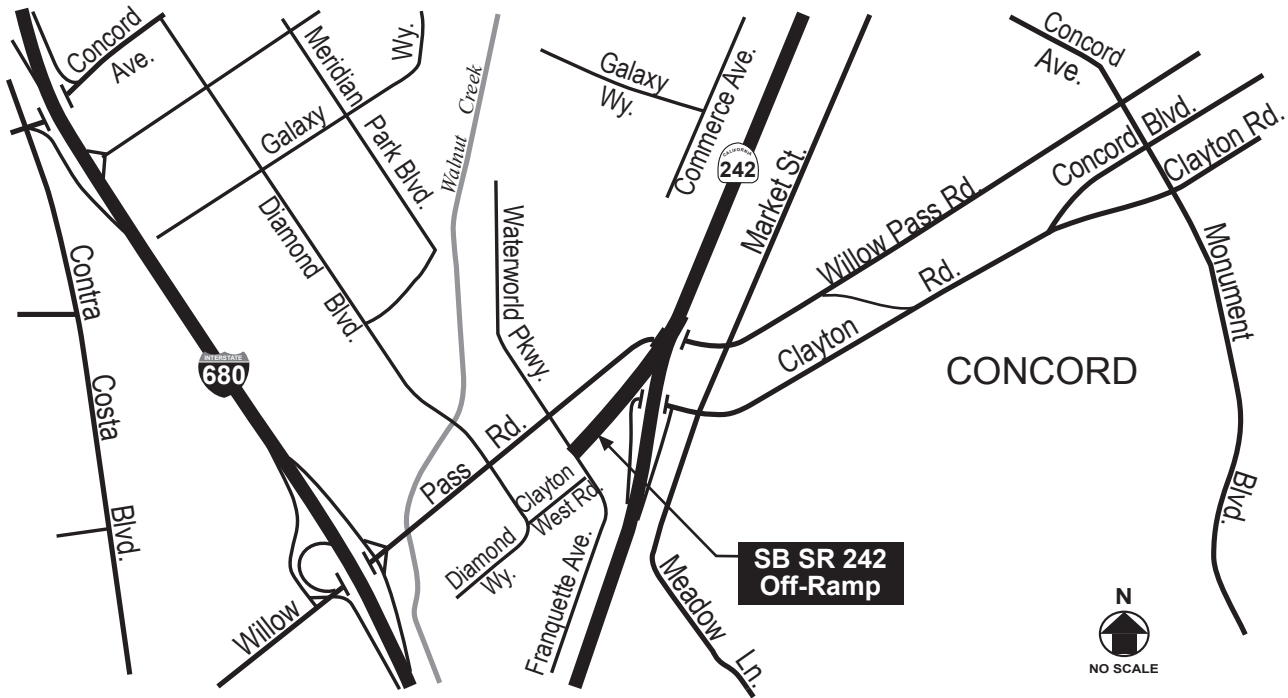

State Route 242/Clayton Road Off-Ramp (cont.)

Need/Purpose

The purpose of this project is to alleviate congestion and balance traffic flows to and from downtown businesses and office complexes in the City of Concord. The southbound off-ramp improves vehicular access to Willow Pass Road, Waterworld Parkway and Diamond Boulevard. It also provides mitigation for the existing LOS D intersection operations at the State Route 242/Concord Avenue off-ramp. The southbound State Route 242 off-ramp would intersect Franquette Avenue near the Clayton Road intersection.
