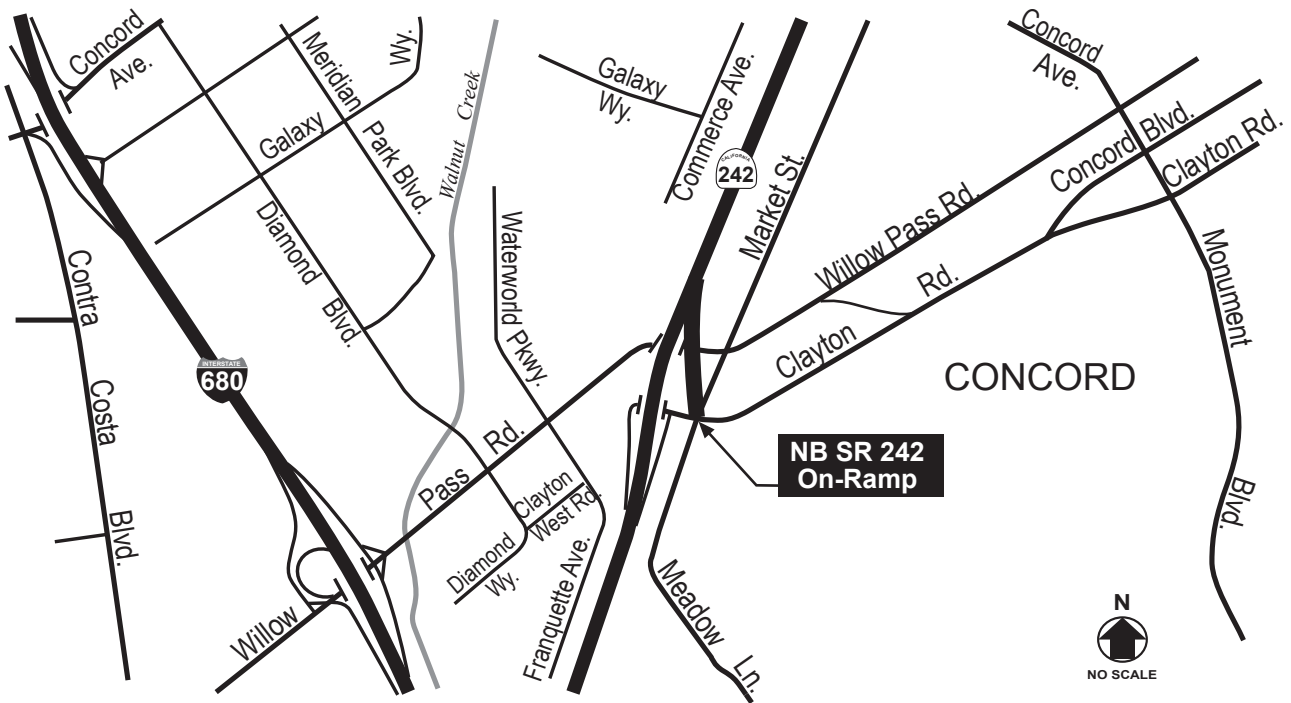

State Route 242/Clayton Road On-Ramp (cont.)

Need/Purpose

The proposed project alleviates congestion and balances traffic flows to and from downtown businesses and office complexes in the City of Concord. The northbound on-ramp improves congestion and vehicular access to Clayton Road, Willow Pass Road, Concord Boulevard, Galindo Street and Market Street.

Possible Segmentation

None.

Issues

Significant right-of-way acquisition and relocations will be required depending upon final design configuration of the interchange modifications. Construction would impact the existing Caltrans Park and Ride lot at the northwest corner of the Market Street/Willow Pass Road intersection.
