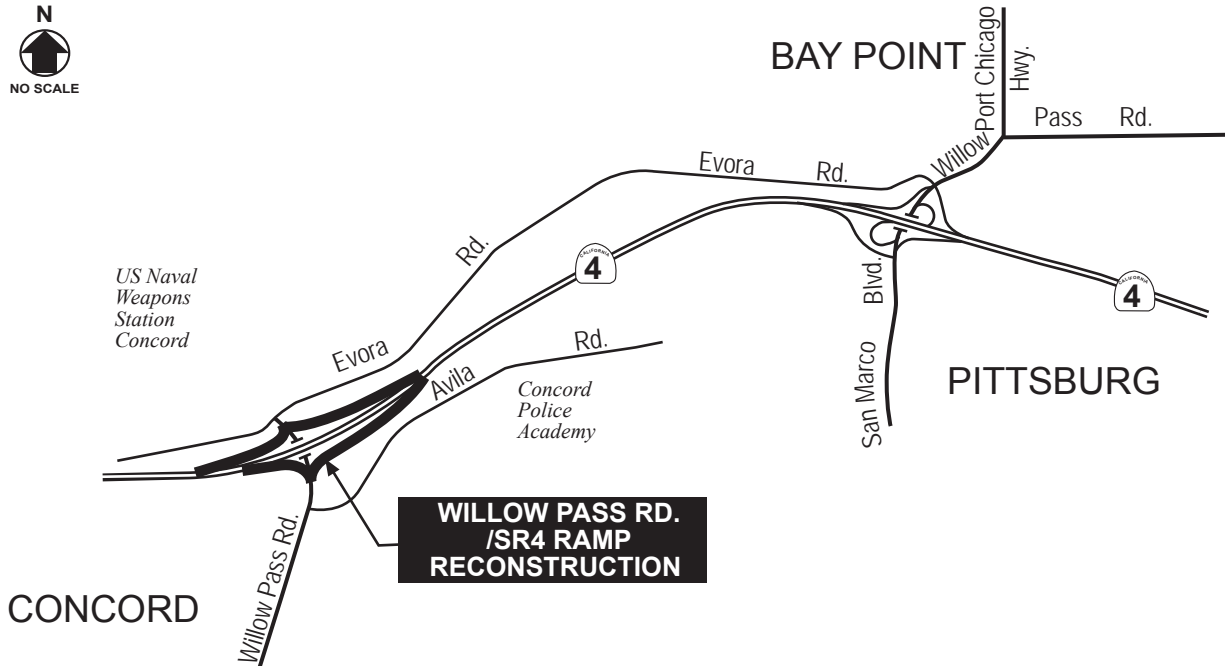

Reconstruct the Willow Pass Road/State Route 4 interchange to improve access to SR4 and accommodate future traffic demands due to development of the Concord Naval Weapons Station.

Willow Pass Road / SR 4 Ramp Reconstruction (cont.)

Need/Purpose

The project accommodates traffic generated by new commercial, office and housing developments on the Concord Naval Weapons Station and surrounding parcels. The project enhances access to State Route 4, and improves traffic flow on the local street system. The project was identified as a critical transportation link in the City of Concord Redevelopment Strategic Plan and the General Plan update.

Possible Segmentation

- Improvements may require significant right-of-way acquisition.
- Reuse of the Naval Weapons Station may attract developments that contribute to the overall cost of this project.
- City of Concord off-site Street Improvement Program Holding Account has listed this project for partial funding.

Current Status

The development of a Preferred Reuse Plan of the Naval Weapons Station has been completed and Environmental Impact Report (EIR) review was completed in 2010. Preparation of Project Study Report (PSR) could occur in FY 12/13.
