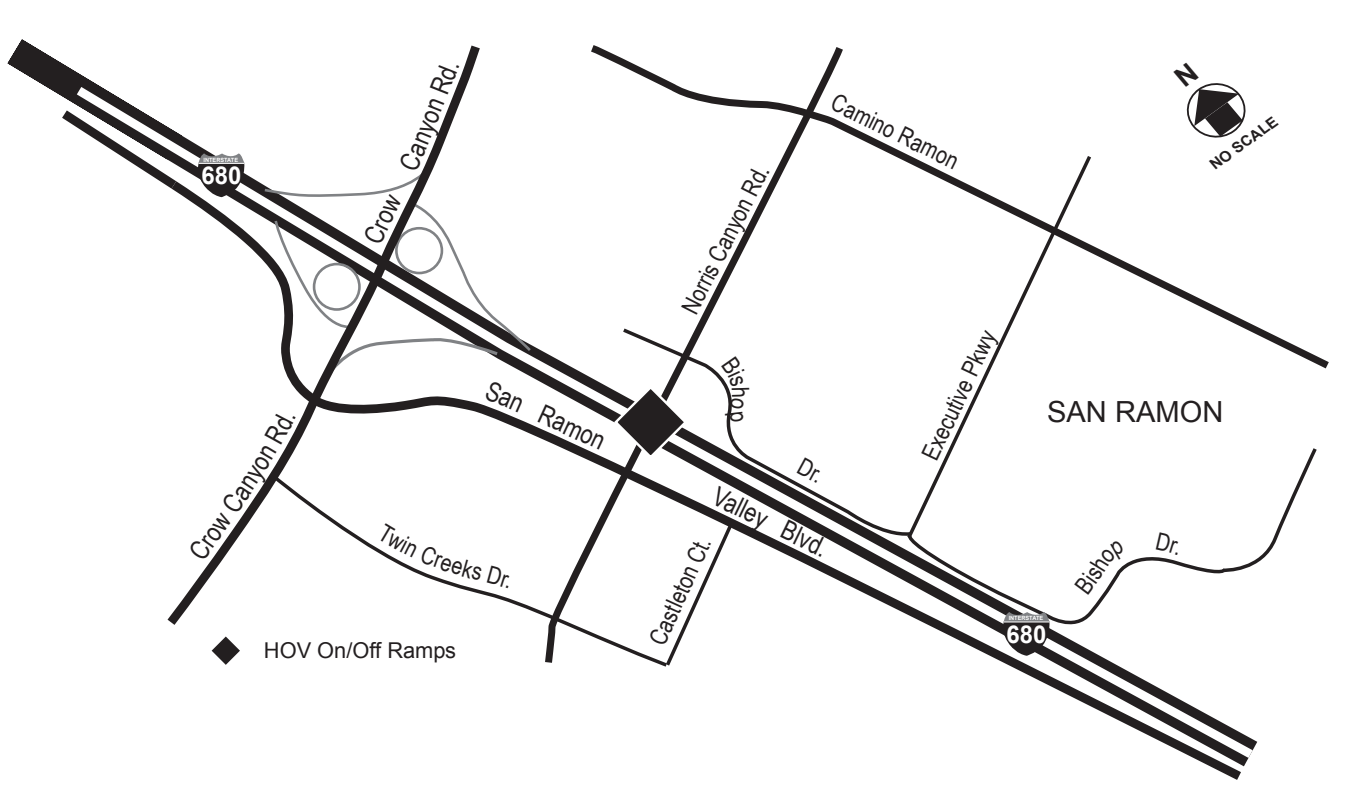




# Interstate 680/Norris Canyon Bus/Carpool On- and Off-Ramps

Construct dedicated High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) on and off ramps at the intersection of Interstate 680 and Norris Canyon Road in both the northbound and southbound directions and reconstruct the Norris Canyon Road overcrossing in San Ramon.

## I-680/Norris Canyon Bus/Carpool On- and Off-Ramps (cont.)

### Need/Purpose

The proposed HOV project aims to improve access for express bus service, carpools and vanpools. Express bus services will link to the regional transit network and adjoining HOV lanes. Dedicated HOV-only ramps also reduce traffic conflicts by reducing the amount of weaving by high occupancy vehicles entering or exiting the freeway.
