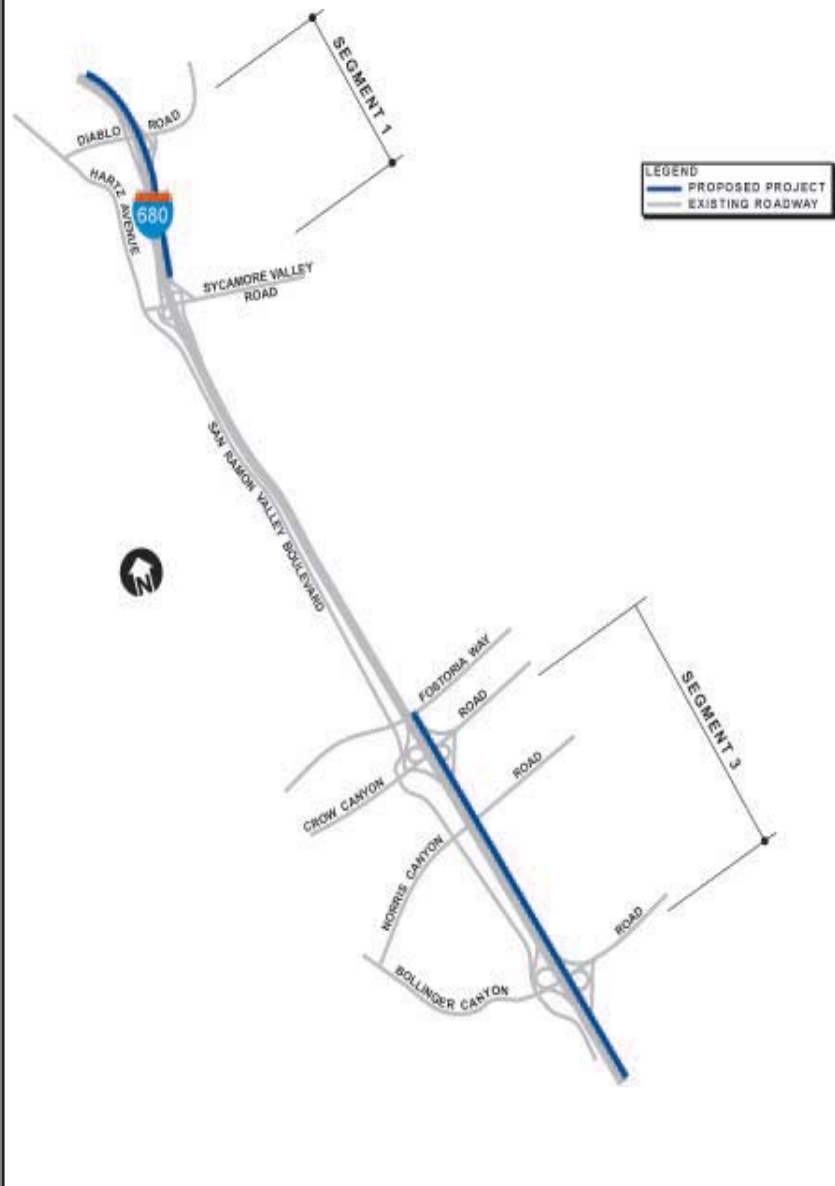

DESCRIPTION:

This project proposes to construct auxiliary lanes in the I-680 corridor from Bollinger Canyon Road to Crow Canyon Road in San Ramon and from Sycamore Valley Road to Diablo Road in Danville. These improvements include an additional 12-foot lane and 12-foot wide shoulder between interchanges in the northbound and southbound directions, retaining walls, new soundwalls, and replacement planting in the corridor. Structure widening will be required at Laurel Drive between Sycamore Valley Road and Diablo Road.

STATUS:

The project was environmentally cleared in September 2002 to move forward with final design and construction. The project report was approved in February 2003. Three segments were identified in the project report. However, only Segments 1 and 3 are fully funded with a combination of Measure C, Local, Federal and State funds. Final design is currently underway for these segments and construction is anticipated to start in Fall 2005.
