

IRON HORSE TRAIL CROSSING AT TREAT BOULEVARD

DESCRIPTION:

This project consists of constructing a bicycle/pedestrian bridge along the Iron Horse Trail alignment, crossing Treat Boulevard in the vicinity of Jones Road. The bridge will provide a grade separation between traffic on Treat Boulevard and bicycle/pedestrian traffic on Iron Horse Trail. Treat Boulevard provides access to the Pleasant Hill BART station and to I-680. The Iron Horse Trail is a Class I bikeway facility that will ultimately parallel the full length of I-680 in Contra Costa County and provide bicycle/pedestrian access to the BART station.



STATUS:

The project is included in the Pleasant Hill BART Station Area Specific Plan. The project is supported by the adjacent neighborhood groups, the Pleasant Hill BART Station Area Steering Committee, and the East Bay Regional Parks District which is the operator of the Iron Horse Trail. Design is 65% complete. Construction is scheduled to start in Summer 2005.
