



SR 4 (E) WIDENING: RAILROAD AVENUE TO LOVERIDGE ROAD

DESCRIPTION:

The project will widen the existing highway, from two to four lanes in each direction (including HOV lane), between Railroad Avenue and Loveridge Road as well as provide a future 44-60 ft. median for BART. The reconstruction will not preclude a future BART station between Railroad Avenue and Harbor Street; however, additional ramp reconstruction will be required to accommodate a future station.

STATUS:

Environmental Clearance was obtained in February 2001. The project was divided into four contracts as follows:

- 1) Frontage Road Reconstruction - Construction started November 2001 and was completed in May 2003.
- 2) Harbor Street Overcrossing - Construction started May 2002 and was completed in May 2003.
- 3) SR 4 Widening and Railroad Avenue Interchange "Mainline" - Construction started November 2003 and is expected to be complete in January 2006.
- 4) Landscaping - Final design is in progress. Landscape construction to be completed after Mainline construction in 2007.
